PROJECT HIGHLIGHT



MCKINLEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CADILLAC, MI



The McKinley Elementary School, located in Cadillac, Michigan, served the community for over 50 years until it closed its doors in 2012 after suffering extensive fire damage. Cadillac Area Public Schools continued to use a portion of the building for storage after the fire, but the majority remained vacant and unusable. In 2020, the decision was made to demolish the structure which would reduce the School District's liability and provide a potential source of revenue by returning the site to the commercial property market. To achieve this goal, Triterra was selected by the School District to manage the entire process, starting with finding qualified contractors.

Triterra solicited bids from fourteen contractors, of which, two were chosen for the project: one for asbestos abatement, and one for demolition and site restoration. By obtaining a large pool of bids from contractors around Michigan, Triterra saved the School District well over \$100,000 in abatement and demolition costs before the project even started.

Fast forward to the present, Triterra has provided asbestos abatement oversight and air quality monitoring to meet all federal and state regulations and provide the demolition contractor peace of mind knowing the asbestos materials have been fully abated with no air quality concerns which could jeopardize the health of their workers. To date, the demolition process is ongoing and on track to wrap up in mid-April 2021. With the excellent work and care provided by the contractors, and effective project management provided by Triterra, the project is expected to come in more than \$200,000 under the original budget set aside for the project.
